Ihlara completed her Bachelor of Music at the University of Otago studying piano and composition. Her studies also included a Bachelor of Law and a Bachelor of the Arts (Hons) in Gender Studies.

Ihlara completed her first year working as a lawyer in 2021 for a large firm based in Wellington, New Zealand.

Anthony is a multi-media filmmaker, photographer, and camera equipment builder who specialises in all things Antarctic.

Anthony's footage has appeared in numerous exhibits, TV shows, films, and magazines. His debut feature film *Antarctica: A Year On Ice* won more than 20 international film awards.

He worked for many years as a Communications Technician and Satellite Engineer in Antarctica at both Scott Base and McMurdo Station, before becoming a full-time filmmaker. He has spent ten years physically in Antarctica, including ten winters.
